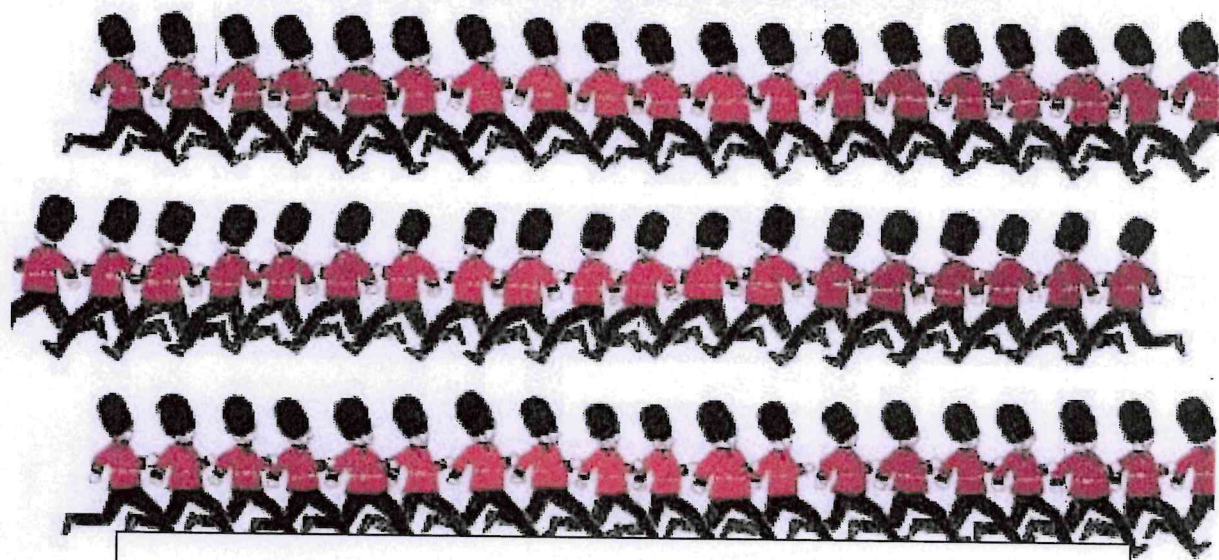
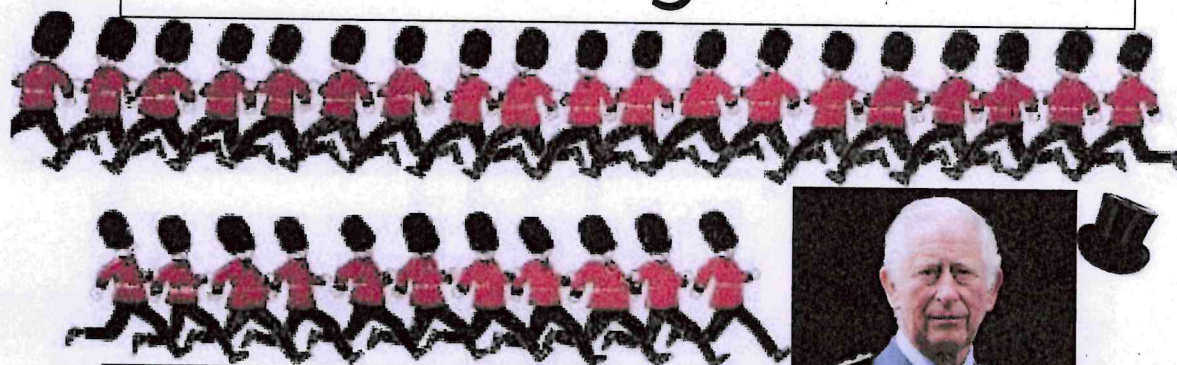

The King's Hat



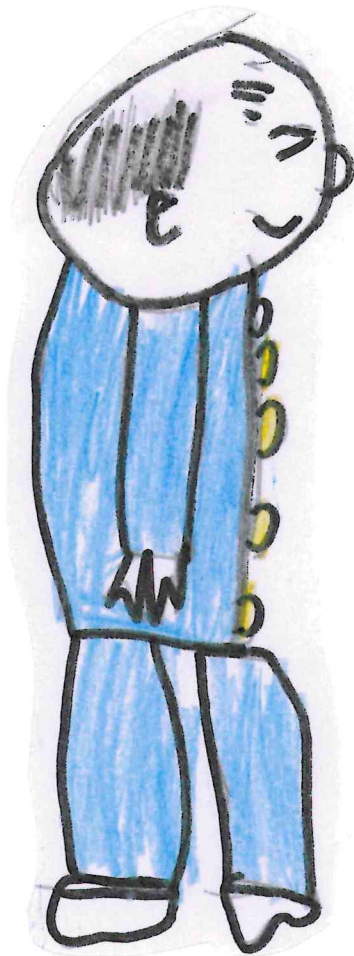
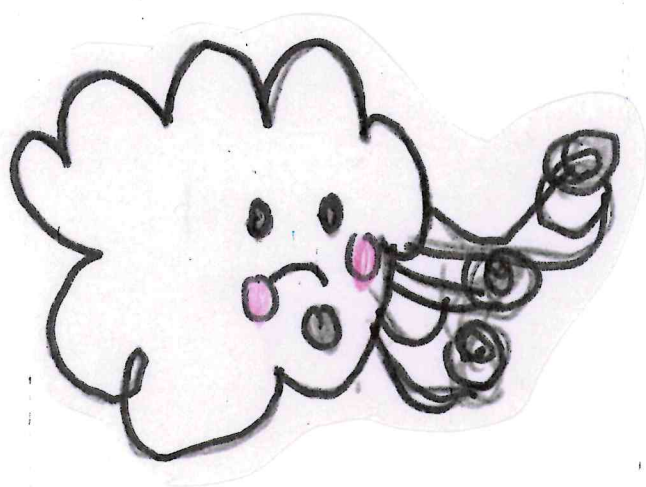
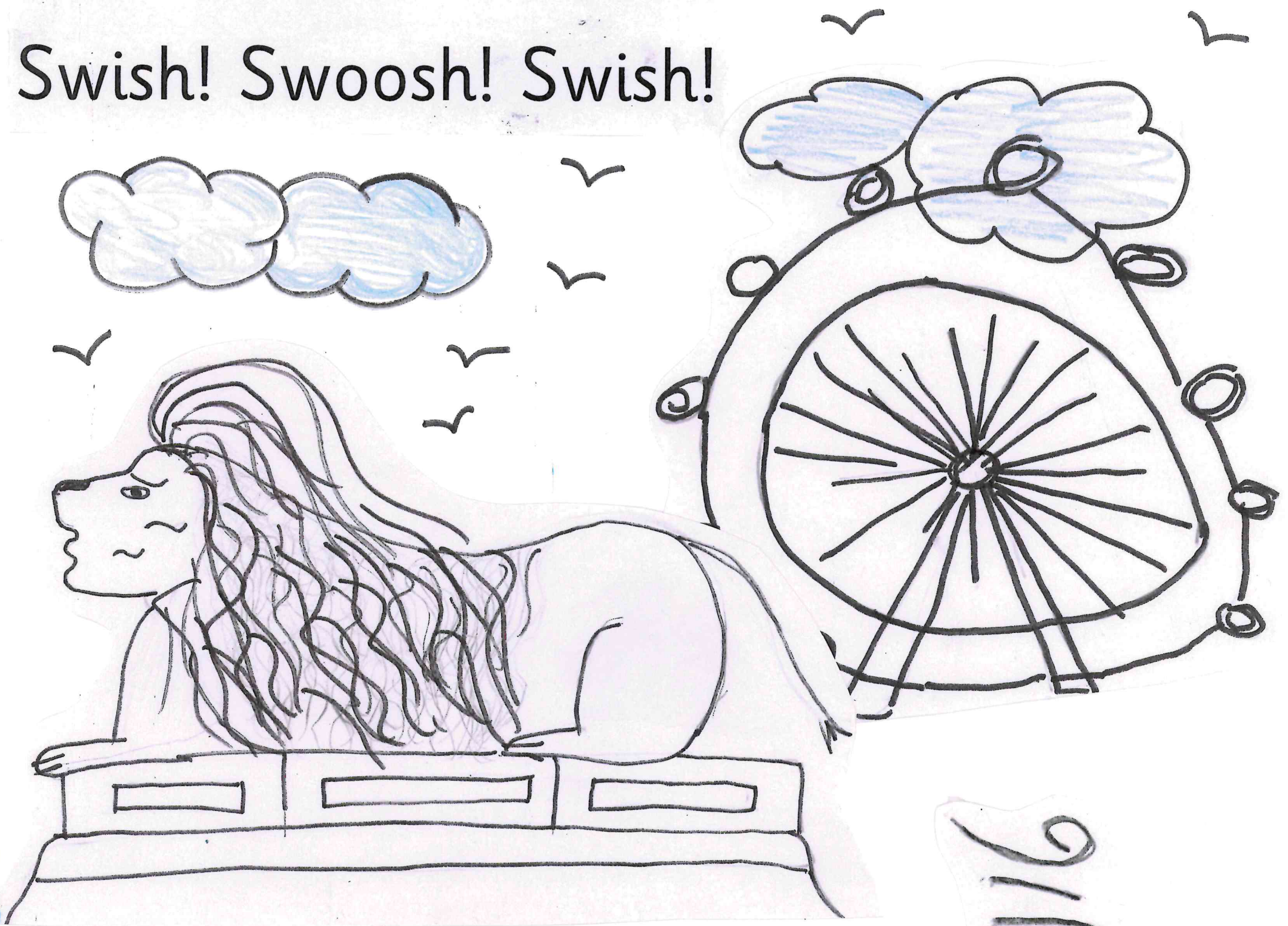

Swish! Swoosh! Swish!

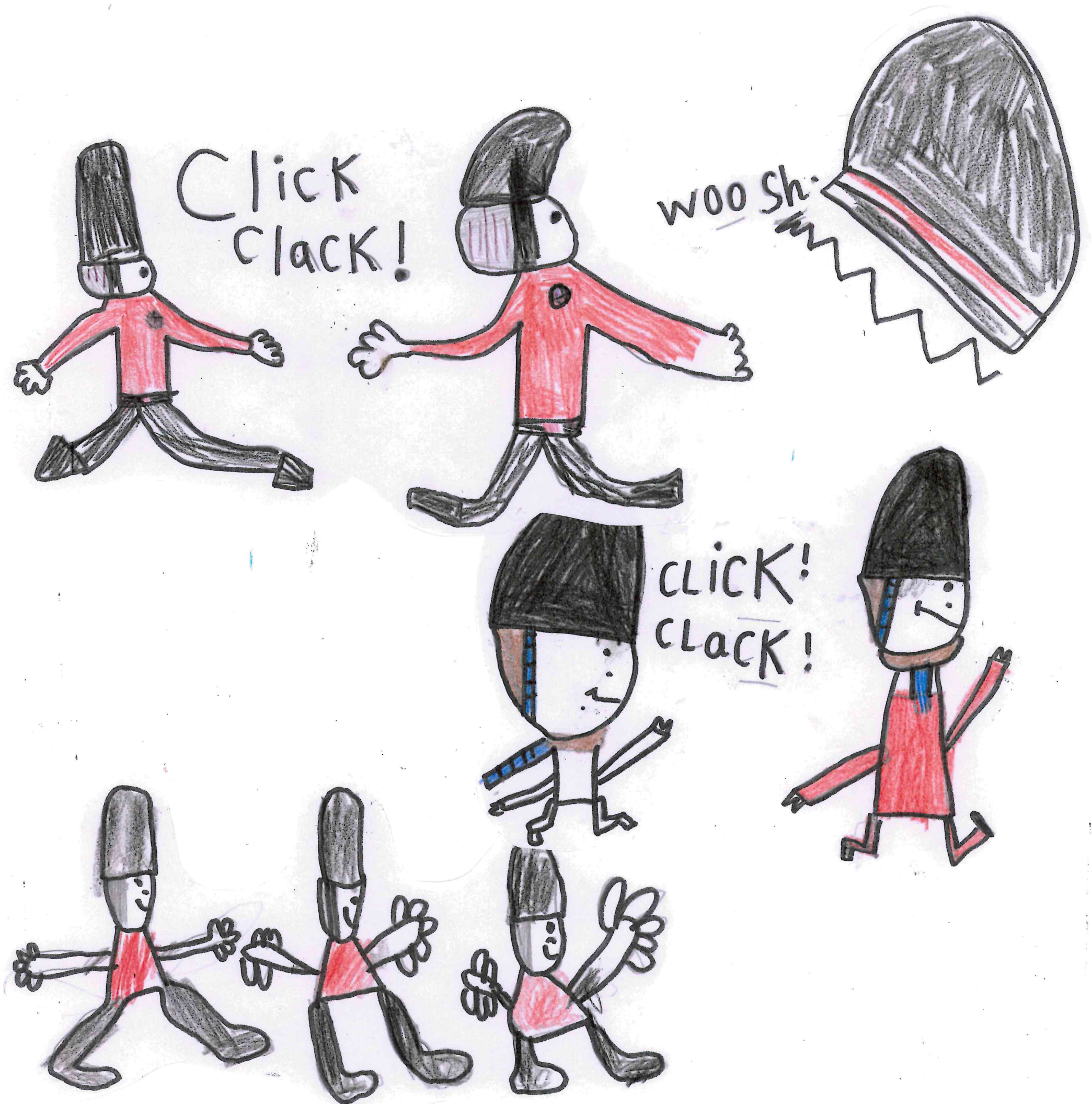


The King's hat blew off his head as fast as a speed train.

rushed after the hat.

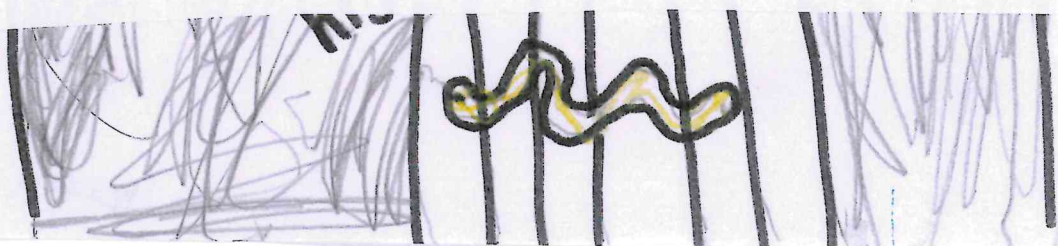


The hat blew all the way to London
Zoo.

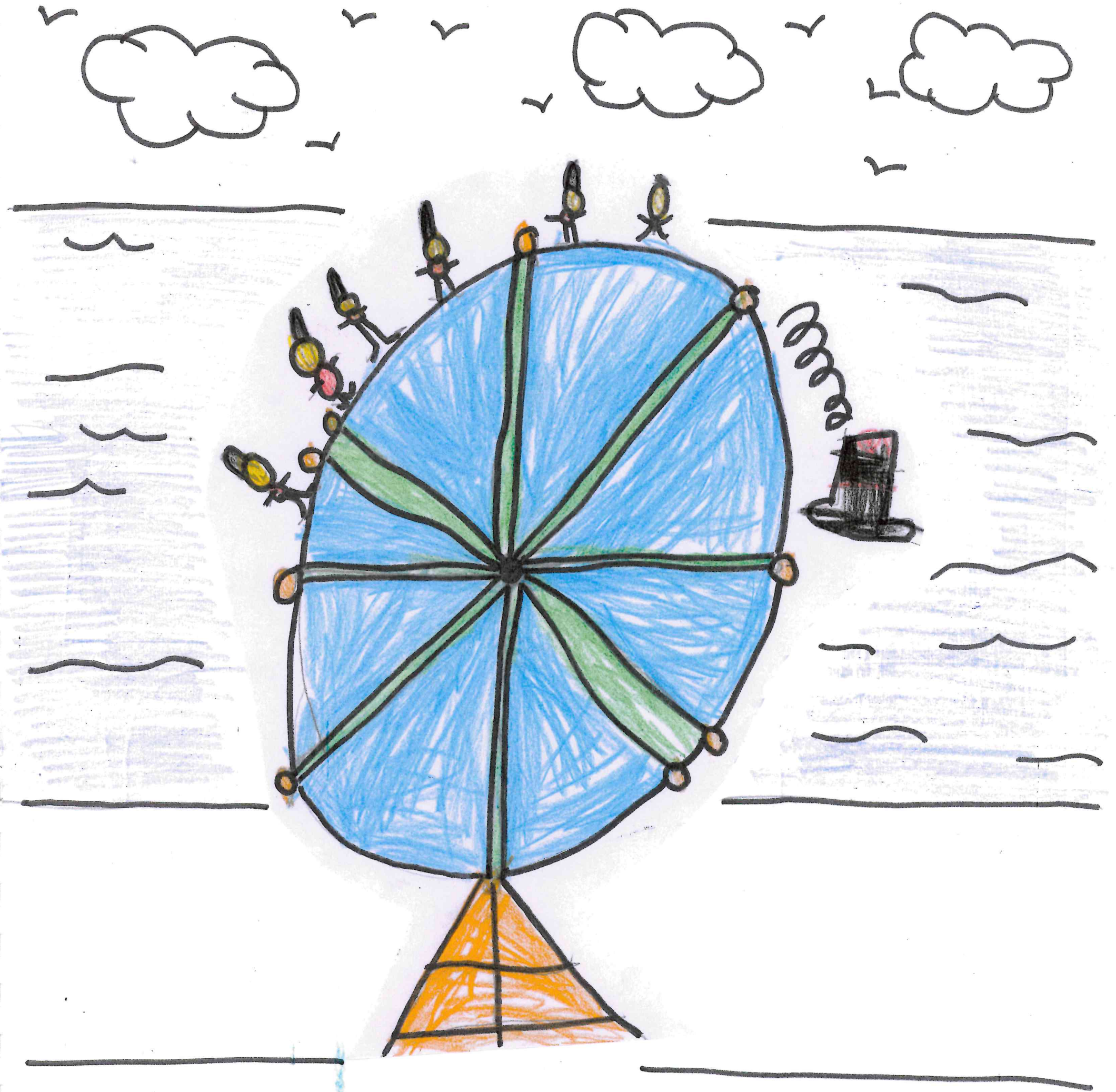
Squawk squawk went the talking

Eye.



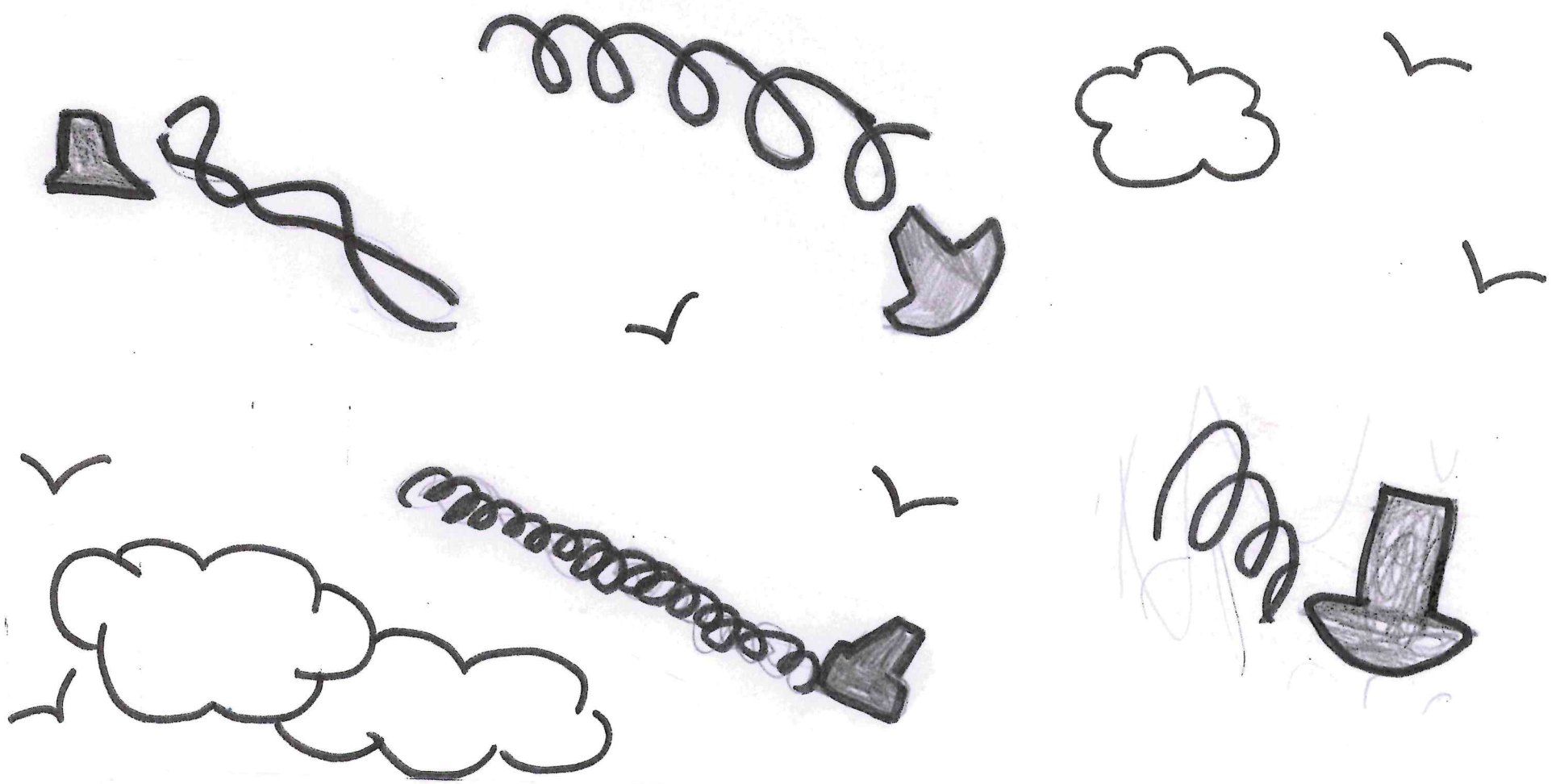
The guards rambled and scrambled

of the hat.



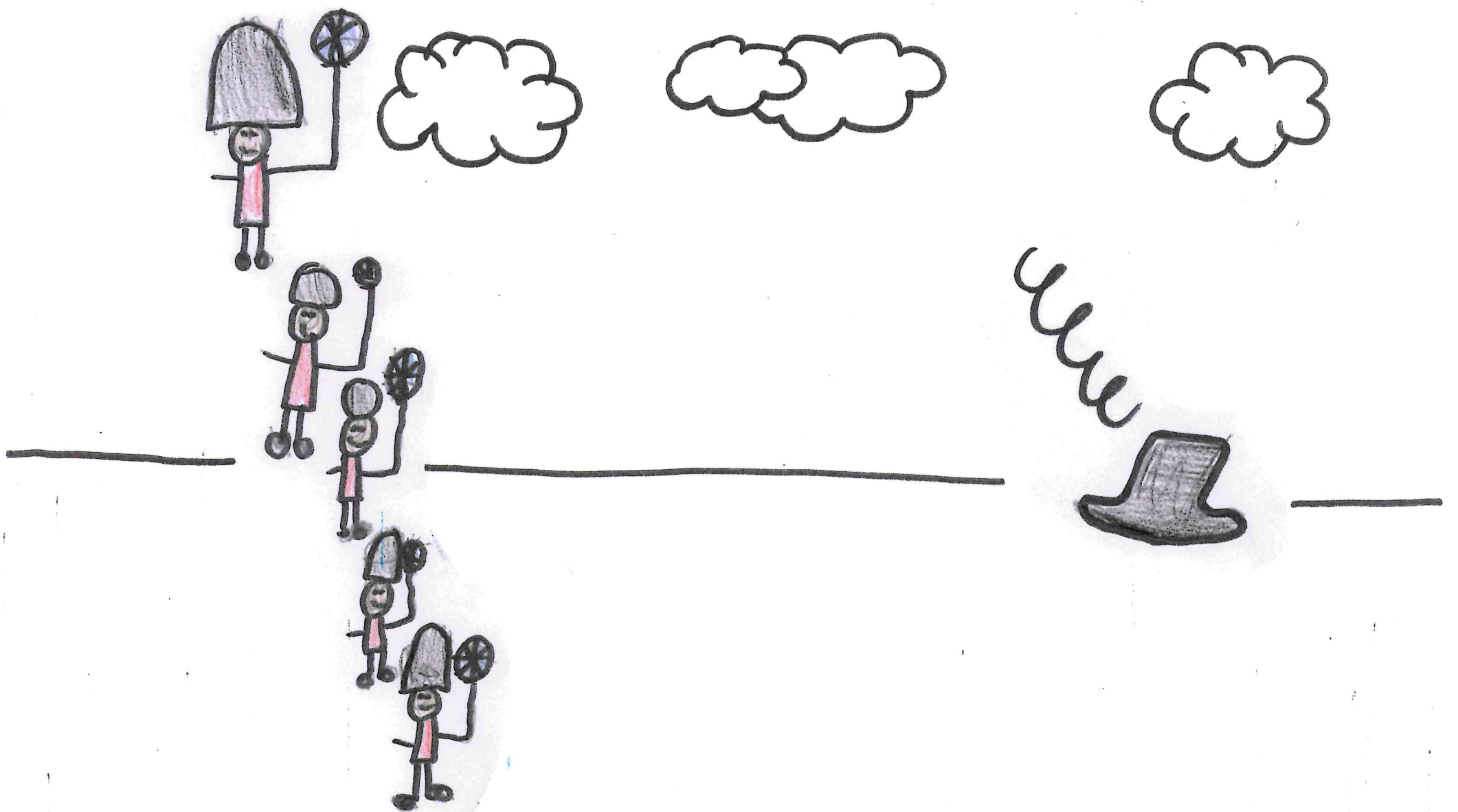


Ding! Dong! Went Big Ben as the
