China is rapidly becoming the largest economy in the world.


• It has a population of 1.35 billion (that's one fifth of the WORLD's population!).

Taicang is situated just north west of shanghai on the river delta of the Yangtze River in Jiangsu province. It has a population of about 1/2 million people. Taicang means 'great storehouse' because in the 3rd century, when it was founded, it had huge warehouses for all the agricultural products in the area. It is also famous as the departure place for Zheng He's treasure fleet (famous Chinese explorer)

Shanghai

- 2nd most populated city in the world. 27 million people leave there.
- City famous for banking, computing, port and sky scrapers and world's fastest train.





Tiacang

- Our partner city. Describe themselves as a 'small city' with one million people in.
- Although it is ancient port. City was largely built during the last 10 years.
- Busy, lively city with lots of parks. Wealthy city.






















Also.....




Head teachers travelled all the way to China to formalise the Partnership and provide you with this opportunity.



























Jingmao Primary School

- Our Partner School.
- Has a separate kindergarten.
- 2,300 pupils.
- Their head teacher is principal Wan.





















Tiacang Schools

- Most schools have 2000 + pupils.
- Kindergarten until you are 7.
- Primary School until you are 13.
- Elementary School until 16.
- Secondary School from 16.
- Start their day at 8.00am.
- Lessons are 45 minutes.
- 10 min break between every lesson.
- Learn same lessons as us. Except their second language is English.
- Stay in school with clubs until 5.00pm.
- 90 min lunch.
- At least 2 hours homework a day in primary School.
- No official uniform. However parents will often create one.
- No packed lunches. Everybody has a buffet meal.
- Every school has a doctor and nurse.
- Every school has a policeman.
- No lunchtime staff. Children look after themselves.
- Different teachers for even subject (maths, Science, history, English etc.)

How will this trip impact my child?

- This trip is the opportunity of a life time for your child to build confidence, find out more about life in China and the opportunities that this may open up, along with life-long friendships.
- Your child will unlock the culture
 of tomorrow! This trip will inspire,
 equip and support them to succeed in
 life and learning. Also, it gives them the

 ambassadors of the school and the UK.

- 2 days sightseeing


You will be completely immersed in a very different culture. It will be exciting, shocking, thrilling and moving all at once.

When is the trip?

March/April 2020 (dates tbc)

How much does it cost?

No more than £1000 (*dependent on numbers) TBC. We are subsiding this. We will get children involved in fundraising.

Is there a deposit?

Yes. A deposit of £200 to secure a place would be required by 29th March. 50% by 30th September (you can pay at your pace). Last payment by 24th January 2020.

What does the cost include?

Flights, visas, accommodation, internal transport, all meals, sightseeing and translator/interpreters/guides.

What do I need? Spending money and transport to the airport in the UK.



Is it safe to send my child?

There are thorough risk assessments and a member of TEP staff accompanying the group. We have been doing this trips for several years working with local governments around China and areas in the UK. This is an added security layer as the Chinese Education Bureau is overseeing the trips also.

What about the Visa process?

We will send you all the paperwork for you to fill and we will explain the Visa process closer to the time.

There will be a preparation for China session before departure to answer any questions and ensure everyone is aware of what to expect,



What clothing will they need?

• Climate is similar. Temp will be 15-20 degrees Celsius.

 Need a few changes of clothes, pyjamas, their school uniform x 2 etc.

• We will provide a school hoodie and t-shirt for airport/travel.

Will the accommodation be secure?

Yes. They will be in secure hotels, with locked rooms, CCTV and security guards. Staff nearby in all areas.

Which staff are going?

Mrs Skarrats Jackson and Year 6 team with staff from other schools. We are aiming for 1:5 ratio.

What about food?

Generally there is a mixture of Chinese food and western food in hotel. Always Chinese food in supermarkets. Lots of supermarkets in Tiacang but minimal fast food.

How will you manage the airport?

School groups are normal. Closely supervised at all times and supported with passport/via control.

Guide meets us in Shanghai.



Will the children have Mandarin tuition before they go?

 Yes. Once we know numbers we will arrange this from September 2019.

Will there be further meetings?

• Yes. We will plan at least two pre-departure meetings in Autumn/Spring terms.

Will my child's medication be managed?

 Yes. We can take prescribed medication (over 50mls will have to go in suitcases). Staff will make arrangements for this prior to departure?

Will the children need a lot of spending money?

No. Just some money for treats and souvenirs.



So what now?

Important information:

Send home form to fill in and confirm your expression of interest and return by Wednesday 6th March.

We will then be asking for deposits before the Spring break on Parent Pay. (29th March). This is when you confirm your participation. Deposits are non refundable.

- You will be able to pay in instalments at your own pace. 50% by September 30th 2018. This will be non refundable at this point.
- Full payment by 24th January 2020.
- Check passports have at least 6 months left following dates of travel, will need them for visa application in September.
- Take a photocopy of the passport info page and submit with confirmation.
- Fill in the health form and notify the school of any illnesses or allergies in September.



Few other things....

1. Ask Mr Cassidy if you want any further information.

2. We will ask your child to get involved in fundraising events.

3. We will ask your child to support Jingmao visit on 9th, 11th and 12th July.

4. We will look for hosting families on those dates for evening dinner etc.
