



## Key Stage 2 Spelling Homework

Each week you will have been practising a different spelling rule in school and you will bring home some words to learn. Please practise writing these words in your spelling homework book and then choose one of the activities below to complete.

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Dots and Dashes</u></b></p> <p>Write out your words in a table and then draw dots and dashes for the graphemes. Count up how many sound there are in each word.</p> <p>S h o p 3</p> <p>S h e e p 3</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Word Changers</u></b></p> <p>If you are learning how to spell words with suffixes then create a word changers table.</p> <p><b>Root word    Root word + suffix</b></p> <p>Prod    Prodding</p> <p>Begin    Beginning</p> <p>Spin    Spinning</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Dictation</u></b></p> <p>Ask an adult or older brother/sister to dictate a sentence for you to write using your spelling words.</p> <p>Maybe you could write some sentences that use the grammar rules you have been learning in school.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Four-in-a-row</u></b></p> <p>Ask an adult or older brother/sister to be your partner. Each draw 4 circles. Partner one reads a word from the list. Partner two writes it down. If they spell it correctly they get to colour in one of their circles. The winner is the first to spell four words in a row correctly.</p>
